

6. Aircraft requirements

- 6.1. all participating aircraft must satisfy the performance criteria essential for competition flights in their own category
- 6.2. For all competing aircraft, a valid Certificate of Airworthiness of the related country must be presented
- 6.3. Each competing aircraft must be insured against 3rd Party Public Liability. All aircraft must be able to present their insurance policy with a copy in English, certified by the Insurance Company
- 6.4. Hangar space for competitors' aircraft will be available upon request.

7. Entries and registration

- 7.2. Each competitor should be a holder of:
 - A valid Pilot License with an aerobatic extension according to competitor's national legislation
 - a valid FAI Sporting License
 - A valid Medical License



The Jury member can be a pilot or a team member.

When a protest is filed, the country filing the protest will refrain from the protest procedure and the other 3 countries will handle the protest. If only 3 countries present, a suitable person can be appointed to the duty. Jury will be determined on site.

15. Aviation day Saturday 31.7.

Along with our competition, Aero Club Lappeenranta organises an aviation day on Saturday. That will not affect our competition flights. The area is restricted and open to the public from Thursday to Saturday. Main event is Saturday.

16. After party

Saturday evening we will host the closing party and prize giving ceremony. More information will follow.

17. GDPR

By registering for the competition, you agree that your name will be published in the start and result list unless specifically prohibited (GDPR) and in addition, start and result information may be disclosed to, for example, media use and statistics.

The information can be published freely, for example by the organizer of the competition, the Finnish Civil Aviation Association and the International Aviation Association FAI, as well as the Finnish Olympic Committee.

Result data is retained indefinitely. Other personal data collected during registration will be kept for as long as necessary.

Entrants have the right to restrict the use of their data and the competitor is asked to indicate any restrictions on their personal data when registering. Restricting information can prevent access to competitions.
